#### SPECIAL RULES & REGULATIONS:

- 1. **ENTRY DEADLINE:** June 2, 2023. Entries received after the deadline are subjected to a Late Fee of \$21 (incl. GST) per exhibitor. Final date for late entries is June 13, 2023. Entry fees will be refunded at the discretion of the show committee.
- 2. ENTRY FEE: \$8.00 (incl. GST) per class <u>plus</u> \$10.50 (incl. GST) per horse for stabling fee and \$10.50 (incl. GST) per horse for environmental fee. Entry fee Class #222 is \$8.00 (incl. GST) per individual. Entry fee Class #244 is \$10.50 (incl. GST), there is NO ENTRY FEE for Class #212. PLEASE SUBMIT ENTRIES AS A CLUB.
- 3. The Light Horse Showcase competition is limited to bona fide Saskatchewan 4-H Club members participating in a current 4-H Program showing their current light horse 4-H project animal. Open to 4-H Club members who are 9-21 years of age as of December 31, 2022. Cloverbuds (6 to 8 years old) are not permitted with the exception of Class # 212 Lead Line Western Pleasure and Class #244 Stick Horse.
- 4. STALLIONS are NOT permitted.
- 5. NO STRAW allowed.
- 6. Stalls **MUST** be cleaned and all refuse deposited in disposal bins provided prior to participant's departure. Clubs will be responsible for a **\$50.00** cleaning charge for stalls left unclean.
- 7. In the Light Horse Showcase competition exhibitors may enter <u>one light horse project</u>. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to advise the Junior Showcase Office of any cancellation of entries. Vet certificates must be received in the show office prior to the Show. NO SUBSTITUTION OF ANIMALS.
- 8. There is no security in the barn. Everyone is responsible for their own animals.
- 9. STABLING Animals entered in the Light Horse Showcase Competition may arrive after 12:00 pm (noon) on Tuesday, July 4; MUST BE on the grounds by 8:00am Wednesday, July 5 & Thursday, July 6; all horses will be released following the final class.
- 10. Competitors in the 4-H Light Horse Showcase are required to dress and use tack and equipment, which are consistent with CEF rules and the revised recommendations and guidelines for the Provincial 4-H Light Horse program. In the case of a discrepancy, CEF rules shall prevail. Accordingly, 4-H Club leaders should assist participants in becoming familiar with the rules and regulations.
- 11. The Committee reserves the right to cancel any class with fewer than five entries.
- 12. For general rules for showing, refer to the Revised Recommendations and Guidelines for Saskatchewan 4-H Light Horse Projects, available from the 4-H office, and the CEF Rules. The committee will be using the current CEF Rule book as a guideline; the committee reserves the right to make the final decision.
- 13. Participants must act in a sportsmanlike behaviour; the committee has the right to withhold prize money and ask the participant to leave the grounds.
- 14. Helmets must be worn for all riding classes.
- 15. Current record book (completed or in progress) must be presented at registration and will be on display during the show.
- 15. Tie Breaker rule:
  - 1) Most number of first place (1st)
  - 2) Most number of second place (2<sup>nd</sup>).
  - 3) Lowest overall time (Gymkhana only).
- 16. Attention Light Horse Clubs!! Decorate your stalls. A prize will be awarded.
