SPECIAL RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. ENTRY DEADLINE: June 2, 2023

- 2. **ENTRY FEE:** \$5.25 (incl. GST) per class except showmanship <u>plus</u> \$10.50 (incl. GST) for environmental fee per exhibitor, must accompany entry form.
- 3. Open to purebred, crossbred and grade animals of any recognized breed of sheep. All sheep and lambs to be shown in short fleece (one half inch or less) except in Class 59. Open to 4-H Club Members and Junior Exhibitors who are 21 years and under as of December 31, 2022.
- 4. Exhibitors are allowed one entry per class.
- 5. The Junior Showcase Committee reserves the right to cull any animal of inferior quality.
- 6. All sheep must have docked tails in accordance with the sheep code of practice. The current Canadian Code of Practice will be followed regarding tail docking, etc. The code will be strictly followed and infractions could result in disqualification. - 7. ALL SHEEP MUST HAVE A CSIP TAG APPLIED BEFORE LEAVING HOME. Tags are available through the Saskatchewan Sheep Development Board 306-933-5200.
- 8. Sheep Stabling: available from 7:30 am-9:00 am Saturday, July 8, 2023. Animals will be released following show.
- 9. The committee reserves the right to cancel this competition if there are insufficient entries.
- 10. No parents or 4-H leaders will be allowed in the ring in the junior competition. If animals cannot be handled by the junior exhibitor, they will be excused.
- 11. The Champion & Reserve Champion Market Lambs from Class #54 can be sold by auction on Monday, July 10 before the sale of the Champion and Reserve Champion Steers. It is optional that the first two placings in Class #54 sell. The owner is responsible to find a buyer for their lamb.
- 12. A selling commission of 4% plus 5% GST (4.20%).
- 13. Class Number #54 Market Lambs will be weighed and split into 2 categories. Lambs that are less than 90lbs will be shown as Feeder Lambs at the discretion of the committee.

<u>Class 53</u> CHAMPION & RESERVE CHAMPION EWE. NO ENTRY FEE. First and second place animals from classes 50, 51 and 52 will compete together to declare a Champion and Reserve Champion breeding animal for the show. Ribbons.

<u>Class 57</u> **INTERMEDIATE SHOWMANSHIP**. NO ENTRY FEE Animal to be shown without halter. Must have been shown in one of the regular classes.

<u>Class 58</u> **SENIOR SHOWMANSHIP**. NO ENTRY FEE. Animal to be shown without halter. Must have been shown in one of the regular classes.

<u>Class 59</u> **COSTUME CLASS.** Exhibitor to be in costume with animal to be correspondingly decorated to match the costume of the handler.
