SPECIAL RULES AND REGULATIONS

- 1. **ENTRY DEADLINE:** May 31, 2024.
- 2. ENTRY FEE: \$42.00 (Incl. GST; \$31.50 for entry fee + \$10.50 environmental fee per animal). No entry fee for showmanship classes.
- 3. Open to both purebred and grade animals of any recognized dairy breed. Open to 4-H Club Members and Junior Exhibitors in Saskatchewan who are 6 to 21 years of age as of December 31, 2023.
- 4. The committee reserves the right to cancel the class if insufficient entries are received.
- 5. Exhibitors may enter up to **six animals** in this competition provided they are in different classes. Substitution of entries will be accepted providing substitution information is submitted to the livestock show office Saturday, July 6. **No substitution of exhibitors is permitted.**
- 6. The Junior Showcase Committee reserves the right to cull any animal of inferior quality.
- 7. The code of ethics for dairy exhibitors will be enforced.
- 8. **STABLING:** Animals must be stabled on the grounds by 1:00 pm on Friday, July 5, 2024. Stabling available starting at 10:00 am on Friday, July 5, 2024. Animals will be released after **2:00 pm Saturday**, **July 6th**. **Exhibitors and their cattle must not occupy the marshalling area in the barn during the sheep show.**
- 9. 4-H Clubs that have not held Achievement Days before closing date of entry must still make entry by the deadline date. It will be the responsibility of the person who made the entry to advise the Junior Ag Showcase Show Office of any cancellations.
- 10. Dairy members may use wash rack on Friday, July 5 after move in and Saturday, July 6 prior to 12:00 Noon.
- 11. Any assistance by parents or non 4-H members during the show will not be tolerated. This includes washing, blowing and grooming. Leading calves will be acceptable only for safety reasons. If a complaint is brought forward to the committee, it will be reviewed. Penalties may be imposed at the discretion of the committee.
- 12. No parents or 4-H leaders will be allowed in the ring in the junior competition. If animals cannot be handled by the junior exhibitor, they will be excused.
