SPECIAL RULES AND REGULATIONS

- ENTRY DEADLINE: May 30, 2025. Entries received after the deadline are subjected to a Late Fee
 of \$21.00 (incl. GST) per exhibitor. Final date for late entries is June 10, 2025. Entry fees will be
 refunded at the discretion of the show committee.
- 2. **ENTRY FEE: \$10.50 (incl. GST)** per class <u>plus</u> **\$10.50 (incl. GST)** for environmental fee per exhibitor, must accompany entry form. No entry fee for showmanship classes.
- Open to 4-H Club Members and Junior Exhibitors who are 6 to 21 years old as of December 31, 2024.
- 4. Open to purebred, crossbred and grade animals of any recognized breed of sheep. All sheep and lambs to be shown in short fleece (one half inch or less) **except in Class 60**.
- 5. Exhibitors are allowed one entry per class.
- 6. The Junior Showcase Committee reserves the right to cull any animal of inferior quality.
- 7. Most sheep must have docked tails in accordance with the sheep code of practice. The current Canadian Code of Practice will be followed regarding tail docking, etc. The code will be strictly followed and infractions could result in disqualification. To view the code of practise, go to: www.nfacc.ca/codes-of-practice/sheep or call Saskatchewan Sheep Development Board office 306-933-5200. Undocked tails are permitted for Hair Breeds of Sheep only.
- 8. ALL SHEEP MUST HAVE A CSIP TAG APPLIED BEFORE LEAVING HOME. Tags are available through the Saskatchewan Sheep Development Board 306-933-5200.
- STABLING: available from 1:00 pm-3:00 pm on Friday, July 4, 2025. Animals will be released following show.
- 10. The committee reserves the right to cancel this competition if there are insufficient entries.
- 11. No parents or 4-H leaders will be allowed in the ring in the junior competition. If animals cannot be handled by the junior exhibitor, they will be excused.
- 12. Any assistance by parents or non 4-H members during the show will not be tolerated. This includes washing, blowing and grooming. If a complaint is brought forward to the committee, it will be reviewed. Penalties may be imposed at the discretion of the committee.
- 13. Class 51 Yearling Ewe will be shown by itself, no lamb at foot.
- 14. Class 52 will be divided into separate classes if entries warrant.
- 15. Feeder/Market Lambs will be weighed on **Friday**, **July 4**th **at 4:00 pm** to determine their show weight and classification. Lambs weighing 99 lbs and under will be placed in Class 54; lambs weighing 100 lbs and over will be placed in Class 55.
- 16. Feeder/Market Lambs will be weighed only once and must be weighed dry.
- 17. The Champion & Reserve Champion Market Lambs from Class 55 will be sold by auction on Monday, July 7 before the sale of the Champion and Reserve Champion Steers. It is mandatory that the first two placings in <u>Class 55</u> sell. The owner is responsible to find a buyer for their lamb. Their show weight will be their sale weight.
- 18. A selling commission of 4% plus 5% GST (4.20%).
- 19. Market animals that have been administered any medication or vaccines must be through their withdrawal period before arriving at Prairieland. If this rule is not adhered too, penalties may be imposed to both the member and the club at the discretion of the committee.

<u>Class 50</u> REPLACEMENT EWE LAMB, CURRENT YEAR TO BE JUDGED AS BREEDING LAMB

<u>Class 51</u> **YEARLING EWE.** Cannot be shown in any other class except in Showmanship & Championship classes. Yearling Ewe will be shown by itself.

<u>Class 52</u> **EWES WITH 2025 LAMB(S) AT FOOT.** Date of birth and sex of lambs to be listed on entry form.

<u>Class 53</u> CHAMPION & RESERVE CHAMPION EWE. NO ENTRY FEE. First and second place animals from classes 50, 51 and 52 will compete together to declare a Champion and Reserve Champion breeding animal for the show. Ribbons.

<u>Class 54</u> FEEDER LAMB, 99 LBS AND UNDER. Ewe or wether born in 2025.

<u>Class 55</u> FINISHED MARKET LAMB, 100 LBS AND OVER. Champion and Reserve Champion Market Lamb will be sold by auction on Monday, July 7 before the Sale of the Champion and Reserve Champion Steers.


<u>Class 56</u> CLOVERBUD SHOWMANSHIP. NO ENTRY FEE. Animal to be shown with halter. Must have been shown in one of the regular classes.

<u>Class 57</u> **JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP.** NO ENTRY FEE. Animal to be shown **with halter**. Must have been shown in one of the regular classes.

<u>Class 58</u> **INTERMEDIATE SHOWMANSHIP**. NO ENTRY FEE Animal to be shown without halter. Must have been shown in one of the regular classes.

<u>Class 59</u> **SENIOR SHOWMANSHIP.** NO ENTRY FEE. Animal to be shown without halter. Must have been shown in one of the regular classes.

<u>Class 60</u> COSTUME CLASS. Exhibitor to be in costume with animal to be correspondingly decorated to match the costume of the handler.
