SPECIAL RULES AND REGULATIONS

- 1. **ENTRY DEADLINE:** Monday, January 5, 2026. We strongly encourage competitors to enter by the deadline.
- 2. ENTRY FEE: \$60.00 (+GST) per participant.
- 3. The Collegiate competition will judge eight classes.
- 4. Collegiate competitors will be marked on six oral presentations and two placings.
- 5. Collegiate competitors must be enrolled in a university/college program in the current academic year.
- 6. There will be a 15 minute per-class time allotment for judging. Judging cards will be scored on the following basis: Maximum of 50 points for placing, maximum of 50 points for reasons.
- 7. Contestants must enter all of the judging classes and must hand in all completed judging cards and complete all oral presentations to be eligible for awards. Contestants will be expected to attend the presentation of awards on Saturday following the completion of all oral reasons.
- 8. Once the completed judging card is handed in, the participant is not allowed to get them back until after the awards have been presented.
- Any participants caught working together or seeking coaching during the competition will be disqualified. (No parents are allowed in the show ring unless helping with livestock.)

AWARDS

- Certificates will be awarded to the top winner in each species class in the collegiate competition
- Buckles will be awarded to the Champion Collegiate Judge and Reserve Champion Collegiate Judge.
- A certificate will be awarded to the Champion Collegiate Team.
